### **Online 4-H Enrollment**

Starting on April 1<sup>st</sup> 2018, North Carolina 4-H switched to online enrollment. This being said, we need your help updating your information and putting it in digitally. We are requiring all Summer Fun participants to fill out a new enrollment form, 4-H code of conduct agreement, along with medical forms. Summer Fun goers must also fill out a registration form. In order to participate in **ANY** Summer Fun activities this year, a new enrollment form must be filled out, regardless if you have filled out one this year already, and turned into the office at least a week prior to the event.

# Livestock Day Camp

When: Friday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>-8:45 am- 4:30 pm

Who: 9-18 years old

Where: Meet at the Extension- Event location is Lone Hickory Arena

Cost: \$10

Limit: 6

Participants will spend the day at Lone Hickory Arena learning how to care for, show, and work with sheep and goats. This will be a hands-on workshop and will be highly interactive! <u>Lunch will be provided.</u>





**Registration:** This year we will be taking registration through the mail and in-person. We will have a sign-up sheet at the Extension Office for these events and the sign-up must be accompanied by the payment for the event along with the required forms. Registration for each event will stay open until <u>one</u> week prior to the event; HOWEVER, spots will go fast so we encourage you to sign up as early as possible. The payment for the event must be paid <u>one</u> week before the event along with signing up for the event. We will not sign your child up for any event unless payment is made.

New Enrollment and Medical Release Forms: Before completing registration, parents should determine the status of a youth's enrollment, medical release forms, and 4-H code of conduct form. If these have not been done as of April 1<sup>st</sup> 2018, you will be required to complete them before completing registration.

Please Note: This year there are new Enrollment and Medical Forms. Each youth MUST have new paperwork completed before registering or complete this at registration. For your convenience, you can download these forms to complete them and either email them to us or send them to our office in-person or through the mail.

**Fee:** The fee for each class covers all expenses including a snack when appropriate, transportation, insurance and program cost, unless otherwise noted in the description. Refunds will only be made if the class is cancelled by our office. Checks and exact change only are accepted; the office does not keep cash for change on hand. Please make out checks to Yadkin County 4-H. Debit and credit cards are not accepted. Clover Cash that has been earned by the 4-H'er through competitions may be used to pay for these events; however, the 4-H Agent must be notified of this to check and see what their balance is (if the 4-H'er has not been in a 4-H competition, they have not earned Clover Cash).

**Time and Location:** Activities will be held at the Yadkin County Extension Office kitchen unless otherwise noted; trips will also depart from and return to this location. A parent/guardian must accompany the child into the building and sign the participant in, leave an emergency contact phone number, and indicate who will be picking up the child. A parent/guardian must also come in and sign out each participant in order for them to leave. We promise to be as prompt as possible about returning from trips and finishing the program. For the safety of your child, as well as consideration of instructors and Extension staff, please do not bring your child more than 10 minutes early to an event.
