# 4-H Age Division Change! Effective January 1, 2019

Eight year olds are now going to be considered Juniors in our age division in 4-H! The following message was sent from our "Head Clover," Dr. Michael Yoder from NC State, that states, "Effective immediately, youth who have turned eight by January 1st, will be considered eligible for competition in all 4-H activities, that year. Thus, youth 8-18 will be able to compete in their appropriate age categories. In turn, youth ages 5 - 7 will be considered Cloverbuds and will compete only against the appropriate standards for the given competition."
