2020 NC A&T State University Small Farms Week Youth Essay Competition Due by Monday, March 9, 2020

It has been announced that there will be a 2020 NC A&T Small Farms Week Youth Essay Competition! This is to celebrate Small Farms Week, which is March 22-28. This year's topic is "How has NC Agriculture affected your life today?" The competition is open to 6th, 7th & 8th grade 4-H'ers across the state. All essays must be computer generated and be 1-page in length, single spaced, with a 12 point in either Times New Roman or Arial font. Submissions will be judged on content (50 points), grammar/spelling (15 points) and originality/creativity (35 points). 4-H'ers should include their name, grade level, name of 4-H agent, and the county they reside in on their essay. Prizes will be awarded to the top two students in each grade level. Yadkin County 4-H is also giving Clover Cash for this essay contest. 4-H Online--Time to Re-Enroll and Enroll!

If you have not done so already, make sure to re-enroll or enroll in 4-H Online! All 4-H members and volunteers MUST have a 4-H Online profile. Otherwise, they will not be considered a 4-H member or a 4-H volunteer for this program. It only takes a few short minutes to log into your account and re-enroll because a lot of the information you put in the system last year will rollover to this year. If you are in need of enrolling for the first time, it on average takes about 10 minutes. Then this would be a great workshop for you to attend! This is a free workshop for youth, parents, and 4-H volunteers/club leaders to attend. 4-H County Presentation Week!-Ages 5-18-May 4-8, 2020

This event is a time where youth get to give their 4-H presentation and receive feedback on it. This will help them with the District competition because the feedback can help them make needed changes to the presentation.

You must sign up for this event by Friday, April 24, 2020 via filling out/sending in the "4-H County Presentation Week" form. This form can be found on Yadkin County Cooperative Extension Website at: https://yadkin.ces.ncsu.edu/wp-content/uploads/2020/03/4-H-County-Presentation-Week-2020.pdf?fwd=no. This form asks you for general information about your presentation such as category, your basic information about yourself, and it asks you to select three of your top appointment times you could come give your presentation. You will be contacted about your appointment time soon after the deadline for this has passed.

This is NOT a required event this year in order for you to do a District presentation unless you have three in your age division and category. You can still sign up for a District presentation (The District competition will be held at District Activity Day in Ashe County NC) by **Monday, May 18, 2020.** This event is to help our youth fine-tune their presentation and get them more public speaking experience in the process. Participants have the option of just competing on the county level as well. Clover Cash will be given for each level participated in. North Central District Activity Day-Friday, June 26, 2020-Ashe County: Ashe County High School at 184 Campus Dr, West Jefferson, NC 28694: Make sure to put this event on your calendars! This event is where youth can show off their presentation skills in the North Central District 4-H Presentation Competition (ask Ms. Madaline for details), show off their garment in the District Fashion Revue (must have been in the top three in their age division at the county level), or show off their talents in the North Central District Entertains Showcase (must have won at county).

Fashion Revue County Deadline: Friday, May 29, 2020: It's that time year again to make your Fashion Revue entries! You must sew something you can wear for this competition whether that be a pair of pajama pants, an apron, dress, blouse with a skirt, etc. We will be able to send off our top three in our Junior and Senior divisions to District Activity Day in Ashe County on Friday, June 26, 2020 where youth get to compete with other youth across our 20 county district! All Cloverbuds will get to go to District Activity Day if they choose. Clover Cash will be given to all participants for each level they reach in the competition. This competition no longer has a state event. Please bring your entries to the 4-H Office by 5:00 PM May 29, 2020.
