## **AIRE (Application, Interview, Resume & Electronic Video) Deadline June 16th by 5:00 PM**

AIRE is a workforce development and college prep program. Youth, ages 11 – 18, are eligible to participate in this program in one of two ways. AIRE Program Options

**Option 1:** Youth participate in this program by completing the four (4) AIRE candidate packet components. All candidates submitting a complete packet will be invited to participate in either the State-Level competitive program (open to youth ages 14-18) or in the non-competitive program (open to youth ages 11-13). Youth participating in the competitive AIRE program are eligible to be selected to attend national events such as National Congress, National Conference, and International Leadership Conference.

**Option 2:** Youth participate in this program by completing the AIRE program components as self-study and/or as part of their local 4-H program. Please contact Ms. Madaline for more information about this competition.

## **Dinah Gore 4-H Healthy Food Challenge Deadline to enter is July 7th by 5:00 PM**

North Carolina 4-H has an exciting new competition that they want you to be part of! This contest challenges an individual or a team of two 4-H members to create a dish using a mystery basket of ingredients. The final dish should highlight the mystery basket ingredients and basic items they have at home. Individuals or team members must identify and prepare the dish, then make a presentation video about it. The predetermined mystery basket of ingredients will be available on June 18th (which can be seen here: <https://go.ncsu.edu/dinahgore4-hfoodchallenge>). Age categories are: 8-10, 11-13 and 14-18. Only two individuals or teams can be selected to go onto the state level. One team from the 14-18 age group will be selected to attend the National 4-H Food Challenge in September in Texas.
