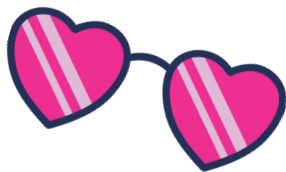

AIRE (Application, Interview, Resume & Electronic Video)

Deadline June 8th

AIRE is a workforce development and college prep program. Youth, ages 11 – 18, are eligible to participate in this program in one of two ways. AIRE Program Options
Option 1: Youth participate in this program by completing the four (4) AIRE candidate packet components. All candidates submitting a complete packet will be invited to participate in either the State-Level competitive program (open to youth ages 14-18) or in the non-competitive program (open to youth ages 11-13). Youth participating in the competitive AIRE program are eligible to be selected to attend national events such as National Congress, National Conference, and International Leadership Conference.
Option 2: Youth participate in this program by completing the AIRE program components as self-study and/or as part of their local 4-H program.

North Central District Activity Day-June 17th!

It's almost time for District Activity Day; are you ready?? The North Central District 4-H Activity will be on Friday, June 17th in Wilkes County at Wilkes Central Middle School. This is where youth present their 4-H Presentations at the district level, where our top talent show entries will showcase their talents, and where the district portion of the Fashion Revue will be! Since this year is going to be so close to Yadkin County, we need to make sure that we represent our county well! So make sure to sign up for one or more of these competitions today!

Dinah Gore 4-H Healthy Food Challenge

Sign up Between June 1st-July 1st

The Dinah Gore 4-H Healthy Food Challenge is a contest that challenges a team of three to four 4-H members to create a dish that will serve three people using a predetermined ingredient, food category, and items from the pantry. Once the ingredient is revealed, the team will have 40 minutes to prepare the dish, clean up and prepare their presentation for the judges. The team will make a presentation to the judges covering their dish, its health benefits, and the nutrients that the dish provides to the body, about 10 minutes after the dish is ready. We have limited space per age group—5 teams per age group (from the whole state!). This event will be held at the Dinah E. Gore 4-H Teaching and Research Kitchens, NC State University. Each team must consist of three to four 4-H'ers and the age categories are 8-10, 11-13, and 14-18.

Here are some suggestions for that question: Position a friend so it looks like a tree branch is growing out of their mouth. Maybe take a photo where everything is blurred except the focal point. Create an image of someone that has an extra set of hands or legs. Use a crystal ball to capture a reflection. Maybe take a photograph of your friend holding up a building with the palm of their hand.

University Communications will again judge contest entries and winners will be announced during National 4-H Week via Facebook Premier. Winning photographs will be printed out and sent to the respective county offices for display during National 4-H Week.
