

North Central District 4-H Fashion Revue Competition Information

Runway Fashion Revue-Wearable Outfit or Garment

The North Central District 4-H Fashion Revue competition will be held in-person at District Activity Day at A&T University on June 15th. Youth will also be expected to participate in a virtual interview via Zoom on June 10th. Participants **MUST** be able to participate in the Fashion Revue Show on June 15th and the virtual

Who may participate?

Each county may send their three top winners in the age divisions of 8-13 and 14-18 to this competition. However, each county may send as many Cloverbud participants as they please.

Guidelines and Other Needed Information:

- Entry forms and garments are due via Google Form by **May 28th, 2024**. The link can be found here for the form <https://forms.gle/VtuSEGVhQMZsn8bK9>. Drop off locations for garments will be **Alleghany, Guilford, and Yadkin** Counties. Items must be tagged with a note that states the 4-H'er's name, county, and age.
- All entry forms must be accompanied with 2 full-length photos of the 4-H'er in the garment(s) that they have sewn. One photo must be facing the camera and the other one with their back to the camera. This is the only time the judge will be able to judge fit, so keep that in mind.
- The entry or entries do not have to be a full outfit, but they must be something the participant can wear and model such as a dress, skirt and a blouse, pajama pants, apron, shorts, etc. They are being judged on fit, so purses, pillows, blankets, etc. will **not** be accepted for this competition.
- 4-H'ers **must** be present at District Activity Day at A&T University in order to participate in the Fashion Revue.
- Interviews will be held virtually on **June 10th** via Zoom. 4-H'ers will be expected to answer questions about their garment that they created while judges review the pictures sent of the piece. If there is a conflict with that date for the 4-H'er, please let Madaline Jones know and we can work around it. Interview dates will be sent out on June 3rd along with Zoom information.
- Youth must pick up their garment(s) on June 15th (time and location will be given closer to time).

Garments will be judged by the following:

- Seams and seam finishing
- Gathering/darts/pleats
- Closures
- Overall appearance
- Fit
- Interview

Awards:

- 1) Youth will be awarded 1st- 3rd places in the age groups of 8-13 and 14-18. All other participants will receive a participation certificate.
- 2) 1st-3rd winners will receive gift cards.
- 3) Each Cloverbud will receive a small gift to help them in furthering their sewing skills.

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Small Sewing Creations

The North Central District 4-H Fashion Revue competition will be held in-person at District Activity Day at A&T University on June 15th. Participants do not have to present in order to participate in this contest. However, someone must pick up their sewn items on June 15th at District Activity Day.

Who may participate?

In these categories, any 4-H'er ages 5-18 in the North Central District can participate in this competition. 4-H'ers are limited to entering one entry per category. The categories are:

- Pillow
- Bags
- Stuffed toy
- Hand stitched (All elements must be sewn by hand)
- Miscellaneous (Any item that does not fit into the categories above that is sewn (crochet, woven, or anything not done by a sewing machine is not eligible)

There are no size restrictions on any of these categories. All items **MUST** be sewn by the children entering them with minable help from others. Patterns are not required for these categories, but can be used if desired. All participants can enter **ONE** thing into each category including the Runway Fashion Revue-Wearable Outfit or Garment.

Guidelines and Other Needed Information:

- Youth or agents must pick up their sewn items on June 15th (time and location will be given closer to time).

Garments will be judged by the following:

- Seams
- Use of Material
- FunctionDesign
- Design
- Overall Appearance

Ages 5-7 will receive a small prize for their efforts. Ages 8-13 and 14-18 will receive 1st-3rd place ribbons and a small prize for their efforts. This is our first year doing this competition, so changes will most likely be made in the future regarding this competition.
